

**THE PORTRAYAL OF CALIFORNIA SOCIETY SLANG IN CHRIS  
MORGAN'S *THE FATE AND THE FURIOUS* MOVIE-SCRIPT**

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**Abstract:** This research analyses the portrayal of California society slang in Chris Morgan's *the fate and the furious* script. The writer chooses the movie script to analyse the meaning and the reason for using slang and the writer also apply to daily conversation. This research aims to find California society slang words, know the meaning of California society slang words, and know the reason for using California society slang words based on the movie script. The writer used qualitative and library research to find and analyse the data in the movie script. There are some California society slang words found in this study. They are *No Way*, *Hood*, *Ain't*, *Bro*, *Ghost him*, *Shit* and so on. The word *No Way* means impossible, and the words *Ain't* means an expression of negativity. The writer found 28 California society slang words in the research. This research is expected to help the reader understand slang clearly and easily. It hopes to help readers speak English fluently, and it can enrich new English vocabulary used in everyday conversation and the result of this thesis is knowing the meaning and the function of California society slang words. Moreover, the characters used California society slang to show the nature of their communication and introduce their origin.

## INTRODUCTION

In daily life, a language is an essential tool for communicating and we cannot imagine what will happen if we do not have languages to communicate. So, language is critical and needed to make good connections and relationships among people in their daily life and activities. With language, we can easily understand one another about what we mean or intend. Yet, language is more than that because language is also something that shows who we are. Language is like an identity to someone because we may be able to judge someone's character, background, and intentions from what they are saying. We can say that language is more than a communication tool; language can also show more than it. Language also provides messages and aims in it among individuals or between someone.

We can find that there are various kinds of languages in the society where we live. The community can produce its language that can be used, and they will understand one another. The relationship between language and society can be observed and learned by a particular sociolinguistics study. According to Chen Linhuw (2013), slang is part of language that can be used outside conventional or standard communication. It also can consist From the quotation, slang is also part of language variety, but slang is a non-standard language many people can understand. It means that not everyone

uses it to speak or communicate. However, variety is considered a more neutral term than standard and non-standard language and dialect. It can create something new in communication.

Slang is another vocabulary or phrase with interpretative meaning and unique word formation. Slang is a term used in social situations by people who feel comfortable with people around them. We cannot or should not use slang if we are not talking to our friends or people close to us. It can make a conversation becomes more intimate. Slang term is used in almost all oral language and is usually used to express people's feelings and creativity. Slang is a variety of language used by a restricted part of the population, often younger or "less respectable" than the majority, and it is based on a very informal because slang is a kind of informal communication that sometimes has a rude meaning.

Slang also tends to the existence of the vocabulary or phrase in the language that can give a different meaning from the real meaning or the literal meaning that contains in words. This means that slang is used not only in small communities or certain areas but

also in worldwide society nowadays. Slang is also one of the varieties of language in sociolinguistics used in people to interact with each other based on the context. We can find some slang words used in daily life, such as texting, direct conversation, chatting, social media networks, etc. Sometimes slang is used in some formal agenda. Nowadays, We can easily find this kind of non-standard language everywhere. They are popular in direct messages, social networks, magazines, radio, songs, and films.

Films provide many things, such as language, characters, culture, etc. Many characters speak a language based on their origin. Films use language to discuss with the community so they can build a good relationship with each other. They make their language structure distinct from the general structure of language. The various language makes the conversation look so close and friendly among them. Slang is also used to communicate but has a direct meaning in the community. Film affected someone's language as it is audio-visual made by humans and aim to give information or entertainment. Many people like to watch the movie. Movies can entertain and give them information

so that films can influence people. It is easier for people to copy or imitate something from the film they love, such as culture or language. By watching American films, which focus more on gangsters, teenagers, or action, people can learn the culture and slang used in the films. It is effortless to find slang words in almost American films because they use slang words in them.

### **The Slang Words**

Slang words are something that everybody can recognise from what they are used to it, but not all can define or understand it. In the oxford dictionary, Slang word is a type of language consisting of words or phrases that are regarded as very informal communication. It is more common in speech than writing and is typically restricted to a particular context or group of people. Finagan (2018) said that "slang is popular among teenagers and college students in general." Akmajian et al. (1998) added that slang has some silent features. First, slang is part of a casual, informal style of language use. Second, slang changes quite rapidly, like fashion in clothing and popular music. Third specific areas of slang are often associated with a particular social group, and hence one can speak of teenage

Slang, underworld (criminal) slang, the slang of the drug culture and so on.

There are some characteristics of the slang word and why many people use it, which are; 1) Slang is a kind of jargon marked by its rejection of formal rules. It is comparative freshness, its common ephemerality, and its marked use to claim solidarity. 2.) Slang regularly transgresses other social norms, freely using taboo expression. 3.) Slang arises as the vocabulary used by a particular social group with specific purposes, for example, as a device for familiarising a conversation. 4.) Slang comes in the form of new words that can make with new meanings or old words with new meanings. Slang is like a fashion or style used by various people. Some people may say that slang is rude, but many societies still use slang in daily communication.

One of the famous slang is the California society slang, and the California area has a long history. The history of California can be traced back to the native American period before Christ. At that time, many people lived surrounded by mountains, deserts, and forests that isolated them from the rest of the world. It gives California a unique culture which we can see today from the

religion, social conversation, and language. Californians are known for a laid-back and relaxed attitude emphasising individuality. English is the official language in California, but they also speak Spanish in some areas, especially in urban centers near the Mexican border. Many kinds of advertisements and some announcements in California use English and Spanish. It makes the California language more developed and quickly can get new languages like slang words or non-standard language.

### ***Society Slang***

Every social group uses some slang. In modern times, slang has become a defining trait of so many societies think that it is impossible to ignore its impact on it. Society slang is commonly used in daily speaking and is connected to society. Every society group uses some slang, and by association, those words or phrases become property belonging to that group. Society is the place where language can be developed. We know that the centre of the universe is society. It means that society slang is the most used slang in conversation, it is the most common slang used in movies or

worldwide that shows the kind of culture in their daily communication.

Society slang can identify members of a group or the users when people use slang in communication. They change the level of discourse in the direction of informality, oppose established authority, and with slang, many people can constantly share and maintain a constant. Changing slang vocabulary also shows more creative communication and makes it look more friendly. That is why the writer focuses on society slang words and focuses on California society slang words.

### ***The Function Of Slang Words***

According to Zhou and Fan (2013), when people talk about the social function of slang, the most critical points will be focused on that language as communication between people. However, there are 3 interpersonal functions of slang words. The first function is Pursuing Self-Identity. Different social and Professional groups have different slang, so that slang is considered a symbol of dividing professional groups in society. If someone uses words and expressions in a particular social or professional group, that person will blend in with the mentality of the group members. For

example, if a student says a sentence that contains college slang, then the student wants results that show and reinforce the emotion that he belongs to the youth group. American scholar named P. Roberts once pointed out that people continue to use slang because they want it to indicate that they are one of the eligible members among certain distinct groups (Zhou and Fan, 2018). From the explanation, We know that slang can show our identity without saying where we are from and who we are.

The second function is the Emotive Feelings of the slang users. The emotive function expresses the speaker's attitude towards his subject. The emotive function is one of the most potent languages because it is so important and changes the audience's emotional status for or against someone or something. Psychologically, slang helps people express their strong feelings, such as group identification and so on. When people use it, they want to show it against reality and release it psychologically. In addition, slang not only serves as a suppressor of identity or group membership but also for psychological needs to express emotions, which is also one of the basic functions of language (Zhou and Fan,

2018). Slang also has a big deal on the emotional feeling of the users. It can be used to express something emotional feeling.

The third function is to Achieve simplicity. For this discussion, it is necessary to mention the definition of register. Registers refer to “a specific way of speaking or writing for a particular function, which is characteristic of a particular communication domain.” The choice of register is influenced by three factors, opportunity (formal or informal), recipient (age, gender, occupation, level of familiarity), and conversation content. Moreover, the utilisation of slang is also limited by three factors. Either the use of slang at an inappropriate event or the use of slang that is not directed at the proper recipient, or inappropriate content in what someone says can damage friendships and good relations with the person you are talking to. The use of proper slang facilitates setting certain moods or maintaining social contact. Slang is often used in informal events and is vital in playing a phatic function. Using slang can maintain friendship and intimacy between speakers and those close to them (Zhou and Fan, 2018). With slang, we can look friendlier to

another person we talk to, and slang is used in informal communication.

From the statement above, slang words have widespread functions in daily communication. It can show the users’ identity without giving them information about it. Slang can also be a language that speaks when the speakers feel emotions like anger, happiness, amazement, and so on. Moreover, it shows simplicity in conversation.

### ***The Reason for Using Slang Words***

Slang is an informal language used to communicate to certain people and areas, and slang words can have impolite or negative meanings if we use them in another group or society that they do not understand the meaning of the words or phrases that we use to communicate. Slang word is only used by some communities and is usually spoken rather than written. With slang words, people who use them can show how unique and more styleable or cool. It stands to reason that slang has existed for as long as the language. According to Eric Partridge, People used slang for any of at least 15 reasons which are in high spirits both by the young and the old, just for fun, for delights in virtuosity, to be different, to be novel, to be picturesque, this could be found in songs or poems, to

be unmistakably arresting, even startling, to escape from clichés or to be brief and concise, to enrich the language by inventing new words, to lend an air of solidity and concreteness, to the abstract of earthiness to the idealistic, to reduce the seriousness of a conversation, to amuse the superior public: this can be seen by the slang children use towards their parents, for the ease of social intercourse, to induce either friendliness, to show that one belongs to a particular group, to show or prove that someone does not belong to a specific group, and to be secret, not to be understood by those around one (children, students, lovers, and members of the political, are the chief exponents).

Some previous research studied slang. First is research by Hafni Ayu Dewi Manurung, Hendra Heriansyah, and Diana Achmad (2020). In their research, They only focus on the term of slang words and find the type of slang words. On the other hand, this research focuses on California society slang words used in the movie or object of the study and finds the meaning and function of the slang words. Other research is from Fernando Carlino Haspo and Rusdi Noor Rosa in 2018, who focused on the slang words they found in song lyrics of

Eminem's album Kamikaze. Their research aims to find and classify the slang words in song lyrics. They also explain the type of slang words Eminem used in his song. However, in this study, the writer only focuses on Society slang words, especially California society slang.

Based on the background above, this study entitled *"The portrayal of California society slang in Chris Morgan's the fate and the furious movie script."*

## **RESEARCH METHODS**

This research used qualitative design. Qualitative research is research that was found as the result of the research based on reality which happens in society. The qualitative research method is a process of naturalistic inquiry that seeks an in-depth understanding of social phenomena within their natural setting. The result is descriptive data in the form of words (can be spoken to religion, social, culture, and philosophy of the research), and it must relate to the meaning, value and definition.

The research's object is the script containing utterances about slang words (non-standard English). The primary data of the research are utterances from



The Fate of The Furious Movie directed by F. Gary Gray and written by Chris Morgan, in April 2017, with a duration of 2 hours and 16 minutes. The researchers downloaded the movie from Rebahin.com <http://167.88.14.149/> and the script from [https://www.scripts.com/script/the\\_fate\\_of\\_the\\_furious\\_20202](https://www.scripts.com/script/the_fate_of_the_furious_20202). They were accessed on May 19th, 2022.

This research is a library research y collecting data taken from books, theories, notes, and documents found on the internet and in the library. The data were collected by watching and reading the movie's script and using note-taking method.

## RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

### *The interpretative meaning of California society slang*

According to the literal meaning from the first datum ( N W ), **No** means **Not or something shows negativity meaning**, and **way** means **Street/Road**. From the explanation before, N W means **no street or road**. On the other hand, interpretative meaning from the first datum ( N W ) means the **expression of unbelievable or impossible**. So the proper meaning for this slang word is the expression of unbelievable or something impossible. This slang word is very

commonly used in daily conversation and can show about impossibility or unbelievable of something in daily life. Moreover, this word/phrase can make different intonation in the conversation and show the feeling of the speakers.

The second datum ( H ) means **covering the head**. The word **hood** has some meanings, such as a **veil, hat, cup, or something to cover the head**. So, in its literal meaning, the word hood is something people use in their heads. On the other hand, according to Slangdictionary.com, the word **hood** means **criminal, crook, or gangster**. According to the explanation, the writer thinks this slang word is weird in society. This slang word could have good meanings and bad meanings in it.

The third datum ( A ) means an **abbreviation of is not, am not, are not, etc**. In the literal meaning, the word **Ain't** shows **negativity meaning in the sentence or the word**. Moreover, according to the interpretative meaning or the inside of the word, **Ain't** means **an expression of negativity or the acronyms of is not, am not, are not, does not, do not, etc**. this meaning is taken by slang dictionary. So, the word **Ain't** is an informal word that we can use in daily conversation. This is prevalent

slang that we can find in speaking and writing. This word can also be formal. This slang can emphasise the word before or after.

The fourth datum ( B ) means **brother or male siblings**, according to the english dictionary or the acronym of a brother. So the word **bro** in literal meaning can be used to call boy/man in communication. Furthermore, the interpretative meaning of the word **Bro** means **Brother, Dude, or Close Friend**. The word **Bro** means **Brother or Man**. This kind of word is also used for formal communication. The word **bro** can be used in daily conversation for people we know and do not know. This word is used to call a man.

There are two words in the fifth datum ( G H ). The first is the word **ghost**, and the second is **him**. According to the literal meaning, the word **Ghost** means **an apparition of a dead person believed to appear or become manifest to the living, typically as a nebulous**. The meaning was taken from englishdictionary.com. Moreover, the word **Him** means **a subject of male/man**.

Nevertheless, according to interpretative meaning, **ghost him** means **to disturb or something to stop**.

From the quoted conversation, It can be assumed that the word **ghost him** means Raldo asked his man to **stop or disturb** Dom from the race so Raldo can win the race. In slang, the word ghost him can be used to express something more than literal if we translate that phrase, it is very different from the meaning. Nevertheless, we know slang has a particular term or word formation with a special meaning.

The sixth datum ( S ) means **faces or a contemptible or worthless person**. The word **shit** interpreted as **an expression of exaggerating something or anything unpleasant**. Based on the conversation above, this study assumed that the word **shit!** means **an expression of worry or feeling unhappy**. The meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation. It can be assumed that the word is categorised into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang. This kind of slang is also the most used slang we can find anywhere. This slang word identically has a bad meaning or emphasises something in the conversation.

The seventh datum ( Bs ) means **stupid, untrue talk or writing**;

nonsense. **Bullshit** can be called as an **impolite word or rude. Bullshit is a term used to describe lies/untrue stuff.** From the conversation above, it can be assumed that the word **Bullshit** had a meaning of **Untrue/lies**, and that meaning was appropriate to the situation of the movie. The word **Bullshit** frequently used in their daily conversation. This slang word is also very common in California society and other areas. This word has a bad meaning worldwide because showing unbelievable or untrue of something.

The eighth datum ( A ) to the literal meaning means **a person's anus or a stupid, irritating, or contemptible person.** While According to interpretative meaning, the word **asshole** means **contempt of humans or stupid/expression of mockery.** Roman tried to mock little **Nobody** about his job, and the meaning was appropriate to the situation in the conversation. The word **asshole** in the conversation above had a meaning of **the expression of mockery.** This word also can show anger to someone.

The ninth datum ( D ) means to **swear or believe** in the literal meaning taken from the Oxford dictionary. However, for interpretative meaning,

The word **Damn** means **an expression of dismay/awe or expression anger, disgust, etc.** this meaning was taken from [Urbandictionary.com](http://Urbandictionary.com) and [Dictionary.com](http://Dictionary.com). From the statement above, Little Nobody expressed his feelings toward the team. He felt annoyed by the situation. The meaning was appropriate with the situation in the movie where the word **Damn** had the meaning **of annoyed** or sometimes, the word **Damn** used to emphasise something. This emphasising word can be found in the written work too. In the novel or some stories, it is very common in it.

The tenth datum ( B ) means a **round object, mass, or round part of the body.** This literal meaning means that the word **Balls** means round thing. It was taken from the Oxford dictionary, and according to interpretative meaning, **Balls** interpreted as **chance or opportunity that got by someone.** The meaning was taken from [Urbandictionary.com](http://Urbandictionary.com). **The ball** is not just an object if we use slang; it could have different meanings. However, this word also has a negative meaning. This slang can be translated as a penis.

The eleventh datum ( K ) means **a young child or person** in literal

meaning. The word **Kid** means a young person or can be used to call somebody at a young age whom We do not know it. Furthermore, the meaning Kid in interpretative meaning is **a mockery for an amateur person in the job most people love**. The meaning of the word **kid** depends on the contents of the sentence. This means that we call a small person or someone we do not know the name of, or we know it.

The twelfth datum ( s ) means **firing a gun**. The word **Shot** is interpreted as **Chance, Go, or Essay**. This meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie. Mr. Nobody gave Little Nobody a chance to do the job. This slang is also used in a broad area, not just in California but can be used in the word wide area.

The thirteenth datum ( H ) means **a place believed to be the home of wicked people after death**. However, **Hell** is interpreted as **a word to express surprise, irritation, disgust, or other emotion**. Furthermore, the interpretative meaning of this word is very common in slang, and the word **Hell** is just a kind of interjection. The word **Hell** in this quoted conversation means emphasising **the word before**. Commonly, Americans use it in their daily

conversation. The writer thinks this word expresses something that gets an emotional feeling.

The fourteenth datum ( Bth ) means **a female dog or unpleasant woman**. In imperative meaning, the word **Bitch** means **an expression of many emotions or a malicious, unpleasant, selfish person and a complaint**. From the conversation, it can be assumed that the word **Bitch** had a meaning **expression of unpleasant**. The meaning was appropriate for the condition of the movie. The word Bitch is usually used to mock someone or something. In America, this word is very common in daily conversation. This slang is prevalent in english conversation, especially english slang.

The fifteenth datum ( H-A), has two words in slang words. According to the literal meaning of the words. It builds from the word **Head** and **Asshole**. The word **head** is interpreted as **the upper part of the human body or animal, which contains the brain, mouth, sense organs or a person's anus or a stupid, irritating, or contemptible person**. So, according to the literal meaning, the word **Head-asshole** means **the upper and lower part of the body**.

The meaning was taken from the dictionary and concluded by the writer.

Conversely, according to interpretative meaning, the word **Head-asshole** means an expression of exaggerating something or anything **unpleasant**. Based on the above conversation, this study assumed that the word Head-asshole means an expression of mockery or unhappiness. The meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation. It can be categorised into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of society slang.

The sixteenth datum ( H-R ) is built by two words: Hell and Raiser. According to the literal meaning, **Hell** means **a place believed to be home to wicked people after death or a sorrowful place**. **Raiser** means **a thing that increases the amount, level, or strength of something**. Based on the explanation, the word **Hell-Raiser** meant **the sorrowing place that increases the amount or level of something**. On the other hand, the word **Hell-Raiser** means **A person who behaves in around disorderly manner, especially habitually**. In the conversation, Mr. Nobody told about Deckard's brother, who had worked for

Chiper. This study agreed about meaning that the word **Hell-Raiser** means **A person who behaves riotously manner**. This meaning was appropriated with quoted conversation in the movie.

The seventeenth datum ( N ) means **highly unpleasant, especially to the senses, physically nauseating**. **Nasty** can be interpreted as **an expression of approval or impressment concerning a person's action/ability**. The meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie because Hobbs came and showed that the man died bloody badly.

The eighteenth datum ( As ) means **a person's anus**. **Asshole** can be interpreted as **a contemptuous human or stupid/ expression of mockery**. Roman tried to mock little Nobody about his job. The meaning was appropriate with the situation in the conversation. The word **asshole** in the conversation above had a meaning of **the expression of mockery**. For the interpretative meaning, the word asshole is commonly used in daily conversation, especially in California.

The nineteenth datum ( Fk ) means **having sex**. **Fucking** means **Express anger or something rude**. This meaning has been taken from the

dictionary of slang. After analysing it, the researcher categorises the slang word **Fucking**. It could be society slang or cockney slang because this word has characteristics such as rude meaning, which is often used in daily conversation. The writer thinks that Deck's mother is unhappy, so he expresses his anger by saying **Fucking**, and the word **fucking** itself is a type of vulgar word. However, The word **Fucking** also can be just as an intensifier.

The twentieth datum ( Dg ) means **dishonest or unreliable**. **Dodgy** in interpretative meaning is **used to describe a prank call**. This slang word is sometimes used in British slang words too. This kind of slang is seldom used in conversation because it is not too familiar in society.

The twenty-first datum ( T ) means **betray or liar**. **A traitor can be someone who betrays another, a cause/antitrust, or a betrayer**. This meaning was appropriate with the condition in the movie because Hobbs told Deckard about his rapor of work when he still worked as a government agent.

The twenty-second datum ( Gdb ), **Goddamn Boy**, means **the creator of**

**disapproval young man**. **Goddamn-boy** means **to enhance or to replace a used word to make the situation or person sound bad or good**.

The twenty-third datum ( Pa ) means **devil or bad people**. The word **Puckass** can be interpreted as **a person who is greedy and does not care about anyone**. This word also can be used as an expression of mockery to someone.

The twenty-fourth datum ( Sk ) means **very smart or slippery**. **Slick** can be interpreted as **extremely smart, smooth, cool, and seemingly effortless**. The proper meaning for the word taken from the quoted conversation above is **brilliant**. The movie shows that they tried to control the submarine. The words **Slick** in the movie were appropriate, meaning **extremely smart**.

The twenty-fifth datum ( b ) means **breasts**. The word **Bust** can be interpreted as **a phrase used to respond to someone's suggestion that you do something**. It can be assumed from the statement above, Deckerd said to a man about what he did. So the word **Bust** it means the **expression of suggestion**. This meaning was appropriate with the condition in the movie.

The twenty-sixth datum ( Fs ) means a display of unnecessary or

excessive excitement, activity, or interest. It depends on the literal meaning which was taken from the Oxford dictionary. On the other hand, according to interpretative meaning. The word **Fuss** means **Distrub, annoy, bother, or noisy dispute**. It can be assumed that the word **Fuss** means **Noisy dispute**. It can be shown from the movie that Dom's son caused all trouble, so the meaning was appropriate with the condition in the movie.

The twenty-seventh datum ( Nd ) means someone who always reads books everywhere, which is the literal meaning, and was taken from the Oxford dictionary. On the other hand, according to interpretative meaning, the word **Nerd** means **Enjoy learning or A person considered socially awkward ( an intelligent but single-minded)**. It can be assumed that the word **Nerd** meant an intelligent but single-minded person because Roman told about Ramsey. This meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie.

The twenty-eighth datum ( Cpp ) means **small air transportation**. It depends on the literal meaning, and it was taken from the Oxford dictionary. However, chopper means helicopter or small plane based on the interpretative

meaning. This word could be slang or just an uncommon word. The meaning was appropriate to the condition in the movie after getting information about where Dom was. Mr. Nobody asked his crew to start the **chopper**. It shows that Mr Nobody asked to start/prepare the helicopter.

The twenty-ninth datum ( fu ) means **combustion or burning** based on the literal meaning. According to interpretative meaning, the word **Fire Up** means start an engine or **express a derogatory statement to an individual**. In this statement, we can say that the meaning of the word **Fire Up** is **Start an engine**. The meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie.

The thirtieth datum ( bcu ) means **a cake made with fruit or fastened with a buckle** based on the literal meaning, while to interpretative meaning, **buckle up** means **to prepare or apply**. This meaning was appropriate to the situation in the movie. Chipper asked her IT boy to check all motor code and warn the swat army to be ready for that. In this situation the word **Buckle up** means **Prepare**.

The thirty-first datum ( sdu ) means **a seat fastened on the back of a horse or other animal for riding**, while **Saddle**

**Up** can be interpreted as **getting ready or to help**. it can be assumed that the word **Saddle Up** had meaning to **Help or Get ready**. Hobbs said that statement to Little Nobody. Moreover, the meaning was appropriate with the condition in the movie.

Based on the literal meaning, the thirty-second datum ( tap ) means **to make a joke about someone or make someone look silly**, while to interpretive meaning, the word **Take a piss** means **Take a leak**. The meaning was appropriate to the condition in the movie. It shows that Roman was from another place in the region. Roman came from africa, where there is no ice in his region. Roman told about his life. Moreover, the word **Take a piss** is commonly used in daily conversation.

The thirty-third datum ( kck ) means to **hit or fight** based on the literal meaning, while according to interpretative meaning, the word **Knock** means **guns/weapons or to strike or hit/fight**. Here, **Knock** had meant **to hit or fight** because Hobbs asked his team to fight/come to the base to get the job done. The meaning was appropriate to the condition/situation in the movie.

The thirty-fourth datum ( Srk ), based on literal meaning, means **back**

**forward**, while based on interpretative meaning, **Shrink** means **decrease in size or draw back, retreat or avoidance**. So here **shrink**, meaning **retreat**. The meaning was appropriate to the condition in the movie. Hobbs gave a ride to Roman. Because there are many armies trying to catch them.

### **The Reason For Using The Slang Words**

Based on the first datum ( N W ) from the utterance between Dom and Letty, where Dom says, “ This is the engine from the boat,” and Letty replies, “No way” Letty used the word to reduce the seriousness of a conversation or unbelievable expression.

In the second datum ( H ). Dom said, “Do you know ?. It does not matter what is under the **Hood**?. The only matter is who is behind the wheel.” Dom used the word **to show high spirits**.

From the third datum ( A ), the utterance said between Deck and Hobbs. Where Deck said “ Welcome to the club ”. Hobbs answered “ I wouldn’t get that twisted so . We **Ain’t** in the club. Hobbs used slang **to show that one belongs to a particular group**. It shows that Deck and Hobbs understand each other about the slang word they use.



From the fourth datum ( B ), the character used this word **to be unmistakably arresting, even startling**. We can see it from the utterance said by Raldo. The conversation is between Fernando and Raldo. Fernando “please. Do not do this. You know, I cannot make a living without my car”. Moreover, Raldo said, “ isn’t my problem ,**Bro** ”.

The fifth datum ( G H ) shows that the character used slang to show that one belongs to a **particular group**. In the utterance between Raldo and his man, Raldo said, “**Ghost Him.**” His man said, “ Si,” which means they understand each other. So the word shows that one belongs to a certain group.

Based on the sixth datum ( S ). This slang word is used **to induce either freindliness**. It can be seen from the utterance between Roman and Tej. Roman said “ You miss some ”. Tej said “ I’ll just wait for it ”. Roman said “ oh.....**Shit**. I hate you Tej ”. from the utterance, we understand that they can be called as close friend or it can be concluded that Tej just makes a fun to Roman.

The seventh datum ( BS ). This slang word used **to escape from cliches, or to be brief and concise**. It can be seen from the utterance that said by Hobbs.

Hobbs said “ Let me tell something. The only thing that I love more that saving lives.....is my daughter. So You don’t shut up with this goverment **Bullshit** right now and star showing some spirit and respect for the red dragon ”.

The eighth datum ( AS) **indicates delights in virtuosity**. The word said by Dss Agent. Dss Agent said “ **Awesome.**” the utterance said to Hobbs’ daugter by Dss agent.

The ninth datum ( D ) said by Little Nobody. Little Nobody said “ if we’re gonno have a chance of catching dom. We’re gonna have to be **Damn** fast ”. from the uttarance , We can see that the character used the slang word **to show high spirit**.

The tenth datum ( B ). This word said by Tej. In the uttarance , Tej said “ It’s just your **Balls** that sized up ”. this word used by Tej to **enrich the language by inventing new words or new terms**. The slang word said By Tej to Roman.

The eleventh datum ( K ). This slang word said by Mr Nobody. Mr Nobody said “ big mistake **Kid** ”. Actually, Mr Nobody used this word to Mr Little Nobody. From the utterance , Mr nobody used the word **to amuse superior public**.

The twelfth datum ( S ). This slang word is used **to show that one belongs to certain group**. Mr Nobody says this word to Little Nobody. This utterance said by Mr Nobody “ Rule number 1. Know your audience, I gave you your **Shot**. You shit the bed ”. This word said by Mr Nobody to Little Nobody. from the utterance, between Mr Nobody and Little Nobody know each other.

The thirteenth datum ( H ) found in the utterance that said Roman to Little Nobody. Roman said “ Who the **Hell** this is guy? ”. Little Nobody answered “ It doesn’t matter who I am ”. from the utterance between Roman and Little Nobody. Roman uses the slang word **to escape from cliches, or to be brief and concise**.

The fourteenth datum ( Bth ). This slang word said by Hobbs. Hobbs said “ it ain’t too late to stop this. It is now.....That some **Bicth** just crossed us.from the utterance, the character used the word **to ease of socialintercourse to his friends**.

The fifteenth datum ( H-A ). This word said by Hobbs. This utterance between Deck and Hobbs. Deck said “ I am here for chiper ”. and Hobbs said “ You gonna do apply for a job, **Head-**

**Asshole** ?”. The utterance shows that Hobbs used the slang word **to enrich the language by inventing new words**.

The sixteenth datum ( H-R ). This word found in the utterance that said by Mr Nobody “ brother owen who could forget him? ...former **Hell-Raiser** and current guest”. From the utterance , we can see that Mr Nobody used the slang word **to enrich the language by inventing new word**.

The seventeenth datum ( N ). In the utterance, we will find that the word said by Hobbs “ well...**Nasty** ”. from the utterance, the character used slang word **for delights in virtuosity**. The word just shows of the proper expression in the utterance.

The eighteenth datum ( As ). The slang word that find in the utterance said by Roman to Little Nobody. Roman said “ Let’s get a hold of a better **Asshole**. No one respects you, ever. Little Nobody answered “ Get away from me ”. from the utterance between Roman and Little Nobody, It can be seen that Roman used slang word **to show or prove that someone doesn’t belong to a certain group**. And from the utterance , Roman also used slang word to show Unrespect or rude feeling to Little Nobody.

The nineteenth datum ( Fk ). This slang word is very common in the daily conversation of the native language. This slang word said by Deck's Mother " I'll give you until I finish my cup up. I'm **Fucking** thirsty. From the utterance , the slang word indicate **to induce either friendliness**. On the other hand, This word also can emphasize the word in the sentence.

The twentieth datum ( Dg ). This slang word is rarely found in the daily conversation because this slang word belongs to certain group. This word said by Deck's Mother " You're about to suggest something **Dogdy** Mr. Toretto. From the utterance, the slang word aims **to show that one belongs to a certain group**. Because this word only can be understood by certain group.

The twenty first datum ( T ). This word could be slang word or just informal language. This word said by Hobbs " ( recommendation Latter ). Highest honor the British government has ever given to a **Traitor**. From the utterance, this slang word used **to delights in virtuosity**.

The twenty second datum ( Gdb ). This slang word said by Chiper " I don't care if you send **Goddamn** Boy scout.....". in the utterance , Chiper used

this slang word **to be secret, not understand by those around one** or just say the word. and this slang word also kind of new word.

The twenty third datum ( Pa ). This slang word said by Roman " It's sound like you've changed. Since you look **Puck ass**. From the utterance, this slang word used **to show that one belongs to certain group**. The slang word that Roman used in the utterance is the slang word that only few people understand it.

The twenty fourth datum ( Sk ). This slang word said by Ramsey " oh, she's Slick". And Chiper answered " gonna do better in that way". From the utterance between Ramesy and Chiper . the slang word indicates or uses **to enrich the language by inventing new word**. and this slang word is rarely found in daily conversation.

The twenty fifth datum ( B ). This slang word said by Deck " You're gonna shoot a baby. You should **Bust it**". From the utterance, the slang word used **to ease socialintercourse**. And sometimes, slang word also made by some phrase that make a new meaning in it.

The twenty sixth datum ( Fs ). The slang word said by Dom " All this **Fuss** of you ". in the utterance, Dom used the slang word **to be differnt in**

**using of the word.** that word looks different with the common word that used in daily conversation.

The twenty seventh datum ( Nd ). This slang word said by Roman. And the utterance between Roman and Tej. Roman said “ I get y’all a lot in common. Computer,hacks,god eyes, geeks, **Nerd**. You know, but we got a lot in common too., alright?. Tej asked “ Like what ?”. from the utterance, The character used slang word **to reduce seriousness of conversation**.

The twenty eighth datum ( Cpp ). The slang word said by Mr Nobody “ You guys..are gonna get along just great, which proves, rule number two, you never lose everything. Fire up the **Chopper**. From the utterance, Mr nobody used this slang word **to enrich the language**. This kind of slang also used in the wide world.

The twenty ninth datum ( Fu ). This slang word said by Mr Nobody “ **Fire up** the chopper!”. From the utterance, Mr Nobody used the slang word **to show that one belongs to certain group**. Because Mr Nobody used this word to order his men.

The thirtieth datum ( Bcu ). This slang word said by Chiper to her IT boy.

IT Boy said “ there’s a thousand of them.” And Chiper asked “ Hack’em all. It’s zombie time. I’d **Buckle up** if I were you”. From the utterance, Chiper used this slang word **to be different**.

The thirty first datum ( Sdu ). This slang word said by Hobbs “ Pray that apocalypse doesn’t come knocking on your mama’s front door? Or are you ‘re gonna **saddle up**, be a man and save the entire goddamn world”. From the utterance, Hobbs used slang word **to show high spirit**.

The thirty second datum ( Tap ). this slang word said ny Roman. In the utterance between Roman and Tej. Roman said “ They know where I’m at with. I try **to take a piss**, I ain’t recognize myself”. Tej Aswered “ tNow, that’s too much information”. From the utterance , Roman used slang word **to induce either friendliness**. Because Roman and Tej are friends.

The thirty third datum ( Kck ). This slang word said by Hobbs. This conversation has different scene in the movie. Ramsey said “ that’s too crazy”. Tej added “ That’s too dangerous”. And Hobbs said “ We do both, **Knock, knock!**”. From the utterance, Hobbs used slang word **to delight in virtuosity**.

The thirty fourth datum ( Srk ). This slang word said by Hobbs. This conversation between Roman and Hobbs. Roman said “ I’ve had enough of this shit ! Number 11 my ass”. Hobbs added “ Don’t **shrink** it. We got a sub to catch , Get in”. From the utterance , Hobbs used slang to show that one belongs to a **certain group**.

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

From the results and discussion, it can be concluded that California society slang words are the most used in the daily conversation in the movie and from the movie-script , the writer got some society slang words namely ; **No Way, Hood, Ain’t, Bro, Ghost him, Shit, Bullshit, Awesome, Damn, Balls, Kid, Shot, Hell, Bitch, Head-asshole, Hell-Raiser, Nasty, Asshole, Fucking, Dodgy, Traitor, Goddamn-boy, Puck-ass, Slick, Bust it, Fuss, Nerd, Chopper, Fire Up, Buckle Up, Saddle Up, Take a Piss, Knock and Shrink**. Those are the words which the writer got from the movie-script of The fate and the furious. All those word are informal vocabulary which only can be understood by some people only. So slang words is good to learn especially for English-learners. And slang word also has special word that only can get

the meaning with understanding of interpretative meaning. We can’t just translate the word according to literal meaning. If we just translate the slang word according to literal meaning.

Moreover, the meaning of slang in the Fate and the Furious movie-script is based on the type of slang used by character background and the setting scenes. From the analysis , the meaning of the California society slang words are based on the contexts. And the writer get the meaning of the California society slang words from Slang dictionary and some thesis or journal references. While the reasons for the characters use California society slang word are to show their natural communication in their daily life and to tell where they are from.

It is suggested to people who want or are interested in learning English, especially for analysing slang words. They must join a group or some area that uses slang words in their communication to understand and improve their knowledge of slang words.

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
