METODE PENELITIAN

The technique we use to collect the data is by observation and internal (Mangkunegaran, 2005:113).

A. Definition of Islamic Parenting

Islam is a religion that encourages all Muslims to call for good and forbid evil to develop the

true religious teachings is by preaching. Preaching is a very important activity because the messages conveyed by the preacher can be known, experienced and practiced by humans from generation to generation. This means that without preaching activities, the teachings of Islam will never continue until now.

According to Max Muller, Islam is a preaching religion that in an effort to spread the truth and invite people who do not yet believe in it, and is considered a sacred duty. Preaching is a religious phenomenon that is ideal normative and is a rational, actual and empirical social phenomenon as the sunnatullah.

This is in line with the view that da'wah is a good deed (sharia and morals) that comes from faith (aqidah), piety (appreciation of God) and Islam (submission) which must be carried out according to the sunnatullah understood by humans in the form of knowledge. According to Syifa and Munawaroh in the journal Islamic, Islamic parenting is a form of parenting based on the values of Islamic teachings, the Qur'an and As-Sunnah. In line with the opinion of Syifa and Munawaroh, According to Fauzu Rachman (2014: 25) Islamic parenting is the care of children in the process of their growth and development according to Islamic teachings.

The instillation of Islamic values is based on the Qur'an and Sunnah of the

Prophet Muhammad SAW. Child care is carried out according to the guidance of Islam which aims to provide goodness in the world and the hereafter through explanations related to aspects of good education.

According to Warsih, Islamic Parenting is to create a young generation that has morals and refers to Islamic norms and forms a pious and pious generation. Therefore, this can be done when the child has not been born into the world, not only when the child has been born into this world. Kamal Hasan said, Islamic Parenting is a lifelong process to prepare oneself, and people can carry out their role as caliphs in this world. With this readiness, it is hoped that it can contribute to the reconstruction and development of society in achieving happiness in the world and the hereafter. Based on the opinion above, it can be concluded that Islamic parenting is a parenting pattern carried out by parents to educate, and raise children based on Islamic teachings, and religious values sourced from the Qur'an and Sunnah. Sheikh Nawawi in the book *Tanqih al-qaul al-Hatsits*, made a separate chapter about the hadiths related to the virtue of educating children. As the Prophet Salallahu Alaihi Wassalam said:

Islamic Religious Education is a conscious and planned effort to prepare students to know, comprehend, appreciate, believe, be devout, have noble morals, practice the teachings of the Islamic religion from its main sources, the holy books of the Koran and Hadith, through activities. Guidance, teaching exercises, and the use of experience (Ramayulis, 2010).

According to Muhaimin (2003), Islamic religious education is one part of Islamic education. Islamic religious education.²namely efforts to educate the Islamic religion or Islamic teachings and its values, so that it becomes a person's way of life (view and attitude to life). In this sense, it can take the form of:

1. All activities carried out by a person to help a person or group of students in instilling/or developing Islamic teachings and values to serve as a view of life, which is manifested in an attitude to life and developed in life skills.
2. All phenomena or encounters between two or more people whose impact is the embedding and/or growth and development of Islamic teachings and values in one or several parties (Muhaimin, 2006).

B. The Influence of Islamic Religious Education Learning on the Formation of Children's Personalities.

C. The Purpose of Islamic Parenting

Islamic parenting is an effort made by parents or caregivers to lead children to the purpose of Allah's creation of humans. The purpose of humans Being created by Allah on earth is twofold: 1) to become Allah's caliph and 2) to become a servant of Allah (Masganti and Raisah: 2019). Islamic parents teach values such as honesty, patience, humility, justice, kindness, and forgiveness. They strive to guide their children to face life's challenges with integrity and high morals. Building a sound understanding of religion:
3. Developing a critical and scientific understanding of Islam: In addition to learning religious values, Islamic parenting also aims to develop a critical and scientific understanding of Islam. Islamic parents encourage children to study Islamic teachings with a

deep understanding, reflect on the meaning of the Qur'an, and use common sense in connecting religious teachings with the context of modern life.

4. Instilling love for the Prophet Muhammad SAW: Islamic parents want their children to love and respect the Prophet Muhammad SAW as a role model in life. They teach about the life and teachings of the Prophet SAW so that children can follow in his footsteps in behaving and interacting with others.
5. Forming an understanding of social responsibility: Islamic parenting aims to shape children who care about the welfare of society and are responsible for helping others. Islamic parents teach the importance of doing good, sharing with others, and contributing to building a just and harmonious society.
6. Ensuring the continuity of Muslim generations: The goal of Islamic parenting is to create a generation of Muslims who will continue to uphold Islamic values and continue the religious heritage. Islamic

parents strive to instill love and affection for Islam in the hearts of their children, so that they can become good successors and pass on goodness to the next generation.

Through achieving these goals, Islamic parenting aims to shape individuals who are faithful, pious, moral, and contribute positively to society and the world as a whole.

D. Keys to Parenting in Islam According to the Qur'an

Being a parent and educating children is not an easy thing, therefore parenting knowledge according to Islam is important. However, the challenges of the times are increasingly difficult. So, as parents, we have to learn more about good parenting so that we can guide our children optimally.

Even though educational knowledge about raising children has developed a lot and is good to learn, don't forget to continue to be guided by religion as the foundation. Allah has given many instructions and rules in the Qur'an so that we can be the best parents.

These three points of parenting according to Islam are certainly in line with what God has said in the Qur'an. Children are Trust In Surah At-Taghabun verse 15, it is stated that: Your wealth and your children are a test, and with God is a great reward. It means:

“Indeed, your wealth and your children are only a trial (for you), and with Allah is a great reward.”

By referring to this word of God, there are 3 meanings, namely:

1. Parents are responsible, but do not have complete control. Because children are a trust from Allah SWT, parents must take care of them with full responsibility and the best effort possible.
2. Allah is the place to rely completely in nurturing. As believers, we must remember that the human heart truly belongs to Allah, therefore the parenting tip according to Islam that we must remember is to obey and surrender everything to Allah.
3. Believers always take care of their trust. Deep love for children is not surprising. This has already been said by Allah in Surah Ali Imran verse 14, so it becomes an important parenting point in Islam. “It is made to feel beautiful in the human view of love for what one desires, in the form of women, children, wealth piled up in the form of gold and silver, chosen horses, livestock

and rice fields. That is the joy of life in this world, and with Allah is a good return.”

Every child is born pure from sin and negative things. It is the parents who teach him external things as a parent, instill the mindset that the goal of parenting according to Islam is to teach obedience to Allah, in accordance with the guidelines of the Koran and hadith. Still related to the previous point, teaching children to obey is also in line with their nature, and this is certainly the correct way to maintain God’s trust. In At-Tahrim verse 6, Allah says:

“O people who believe! Protect yourself and your family from the fire of hell whose fuel is people and stones; the guardians are rough, hard angels, who do not disobey God against what He commands them and always do what is commanded.”

KESIMPULAN

Related to the conclusions of the material and results that have been carried out in the observation of Islamic parenting and the practice of performing aqiqah for children:

1. Islamic parenting involves teaching and implementing religious values in educating and

guiding children. This includes introducing Islamic teachings, encouraging worship practices, and forming a strong religious identity in children.

2. Performing aqiqah for children is a practice in Islam that involves the slaughter of sacrificial animals as a form of sacrifice and gratitude to Allah for the gift of the birth of a child.
